# SOBHD 2012 CHAMPIONSHIP STEPS

## 2012 Championship steps as set by SOBHD

### CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. This competition is registered with TSCHDI - T328/2012 & ABHDI – C1/2012 and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by SOBHD and as adopted by ABHDI.
2. Teachers, interested parties or any other unauthorised person must not communicate with Judges during the Championships. All enquiries to the official table.
3. A competitor who has taken part in any so called Championship not recognised by the Board or any person who has acted as a judge at such an event, shall be ineligible to compete or judge in any recognised Championship or Competition under SOBHD rules until given permission to do so by the Board. Such permission may be withheld for as long as a Board may decide.
4. According to SOBHD rules, there must be at least six entries in advance of the competition date, and at least six of these must take part on the day for the Championship to go ahead. In the event of less than six competitors dancing in any one championship, section will be danced but the Championship will not be recognised. No certificate, trophy or sash will be presented, but individual prize money will be paid.
5. Competitors do not have to remain in the marshalling area but must return for the correct order of ballot. The onus is on the competitor to return in time for the correct order of ballot. (ABHDI Technical 5/10/85 P 3 ratified ABHDI 6/10/85 P 8).
6. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event, must be made in writing giving the complainants full name and address, and shall be lodged with the Organiser, if possible, on the day of the event, certainly not later than 48 hours after the event. Such complaint to be accompanied by a fee as determined by the ABHDI which is refundable if protest upheld.
7. All placegetters in Championships are to be dressed in **KILT** for trophy presentation.
8. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9.
  - a) With the advent of video equipment there be no restrictions on the usage of video equipment provided permission is obtained from the organisers and judges and it does not interfere with the smooth organisation of the competition/championship or in any way restrict the view of the judge/s.
  - b) That judges and organisers should bear in mind that the judge's decision is final and cannot be subjected to a video replay.

# HIGHLAND DANCE TASMANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS AND SUPPORTING EVENTS

**SATURDAY 7 APRIL 2012**

## GENERAL RULES

1. This competition is registered with the Tasmanian State Committee of Highland Dancing Inc (Reg No T328/2012, and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by SOBHD and as adopted by ABHDI.
2. Dancers must be registered and present registration card on the day of competition.
3. Age to be taken as at date of competition.
4. Pre-Premier – Eligibility for Pre-Premier sections will apply as at the date of competition and shall be in accordance with SOBHD Registration Scheme.
5. Dancers compete entirely at their own risk.
6. Dancers entering sections when ineligible shall forfeit their entry fee.
7. Competitors arriving late for a section will not be allowed to compete if that section has been completed.
8. Dancers must “fill in” for reels if requested by the Organiser. If a competitor fails to fill in, unless for a medical reason, the Organiser has the right to enforce the rule re SOBHD/ABHDI Rules and Regulations handbook which reads “Provided due prominence is given to the fact in the programme or in a brochure by the Organiser, then during the course of a competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of a competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification, but a full report on any such misconduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser.”
9. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, substitute a Judge and/or alter the programme at their discretion.
10. Subject to the official protest ruling, the Judge’s decision is final.
11. Any complaint made by an individual against the Organisation or the adjudication of an event must be made in writing stating the complainant’s full name and address and be lodged with the Organiser, if possible, on the day of the event, and not later than 48 hours after the event. The complaint must be accompanied by a fee of \$5, which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
12. For the presentation of prizes, dancers MUST be in Kilt or National Costume. Numbers must be worn for the prize-giving ceremony.
13. **NO FLASH** photography whilst the dancing is in progress.
14. **NO SMOKING** allowed in Competition Venue.
15. The ABHDI direct that dancers use dressing rooms to change costume, and to dress fully, appropriately and respectfully when in public at competitions.

16. **ENTRIES CLOSE 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2012.** Late entries will be accepted until the 29<sup>th</sup> February 2012 and will incur a \$30 late fee. No entries will be accepted at the competition with the exception of the CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS CHAMPIONSHIP OF AUSTRALIA. Any competitor gaining a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> placing in a SOBHD recognised Championship after the closing date and prior to the event will be eligible to enter. Please notify Lorraine Hay, 14 Columbus Drive, Blackstone Heights, Tas 7250 in writing if eligible after closing date. TELEPHONE and EMAIL entries will not be accepted.
17. Cheque and money orders to be made payable to the TSCHDI.
18. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes in classification, the Competition Secretary must be notified PRIOR to competition day.
19. Refunds will only be given on production of a medical certificate and if the Competition Secretary is advised in writing prior to the event. No refunds will be given if a dancer does not meet the criteria above or does not compete on the day.
20. **Premier (with Restriction) ELIGIBILITY** – The National Dances & Trophy Dance are open to Premier Dancers who have not been successful in gaining 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any registered Championship.

Any rules pertaining to Competitions and/or Championships released from SOBHD or ABHDI from time of printing this Schedule and actual date of competition will be adhered to.

16. **ENTRIES CLOSE 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2012.** Late entries will be accepted until the 29<sup>th</sup> February 2012 and will incur a \$30 late fee. No entries will be accepted at the competition with the exception of the CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS CHAMPIONSHIP OF AUSTRALIA. Any competitor gaining a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> placing in a SOBHD recognised Championship after the closing date and prior to the event will be eligible to enter. Please notify Lorraine Hay, 14 Columbus Drive, Blackstone Heights, Tas 7250 in writing if eligible after closing date. TELEPHONE and EMAIL entries will not be accepted.
17. Cheque and money orders to be made payable to the TSCHDI.
18. If after submitting an entry a competitor changes in classification, the Competition Secretary must be notified PRIOR to competition day.
19. Refunds will only be given on production of a medical certificate and if the Competition Secretary is advised in writing prior to the event. No refunds will be given if a dancer does not meet the criteria above or does not compete on the day.
20. **Eligibility for Champion of Champions Championship of Australia**
  - ❖ Entrants must have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in an ABHDI or SOBHD recognised Championship to be eligible. Proof of eligibility to be enclosed with Entry Form.
  - ❖ Special Award for the Highest Placed Australian Dancer in Champion of Champions Championship of Australia awarded in all three sections. Qualification for this Special Award as per SOBHD rule covering qualification by birth or by residency – competitor must qualify by birth or by having been a resident in Australia for six months immediately prior to the event.
21. To allow overall placegetters (1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>), to receive and hold the Champion of Champions Championship of Australia Perpetual Trophies, a refundable bond of \$100.00 will be charged; such bond refundable upon the Perpetual Trophy being returned in the same condition in which it was received. A copy of Condition Report, signed by both parties, will be given to recipient. The protective carrier provided, and labelled "Property of ABHDI" must also be returned with the Perpetual Trophy. It is also requested that trophies are not subject to any alcoholic substance being consumed from same. Placegetters residing outwith Australia will be presented with Perpetual Trophy but Perpetual Trophy will be retained within Australia.
